Entries must include the use of King Arthur Cake Flour and/or King Arthur Unbleached All-Purpose Flour and/or King Arthur Gluten-Free Flour in the recipe. Cupcakes, frosting and any fillings must be made from scratch, no mixes or premade frostings/fillings can be used. Entries are classified by DIVISION (age of entrant) and CATEGORY (cupcake type). Competitors may submit up to three entries per entry registration fee. *All entry forms along with payment must be received by March 8, 2019.*

🗆 Youth	Competitor between the ages of 6-12. An adult can help bake the entry but the child/junior must then complete decorating the entry themselves.	\$5/entry
🗆 Teen	Competitor(s) must be currently enrolled in high school and/or between the ages of 13-18.	\$5/entry
Culinary Student	Competitor(s) currently enrolled in a post-secondary Culinary or Baking and Pastry Arts program.	\$10/entry
Adult Competitor may be a home baker, self-taught decorator, trained professional working in the baking & pastry field, etc.		\$15/entry

CATEGORY SELECTION

Select all that apply; competitors may submit up to three entries for each entry fee paid. Each entry can only be in one Category. <u>Recipe must</u> <u>accompany each entry</u>. Entries must not require refrigeration. Submit ten (10) cupcakes per entry. Refer to the competition rules and regulations for additional information.

□ Gluten-Free	Any cupcake, sweet or savory, which is made with gluten-free flour(s). Submit ten (10) cupcakes. Must not require refrigeration.
Common Ingredient:	Any cupcake that includes chocolate as a primary flavor. The chocolate can be in one or more formats
Chocolate	(cocoa powder, cocoa nibs, chocolate). Submit ten (10) cupcakes. Must not require refrigeration.
Unusual Vegetable	Any cupcake, sweet or savory, which uses a vegetable as a primary/key ingredient. Submit ten (10)
Combination	cupcakes. Must not require refrigeration.
Botanical Inspired	Any cupcake, sweet or savory, which uses edible plants (herbs, flowers, leaves) as a key ingredient and/or flavor. Submit ten (10) cupcakes. Must not require refrigeration.





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COMPETITION RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

The Cupcake Taste-off is part of the Bristol Cake Show and is open to baking enthusiasts of all ages and skill levels. Competitors may be youth/teens, home bakers, culinary students, professional pastry chefs or individuals working in the culinary field.

Entries are classified by DIVISION (age of entrant) and CATEGORY (cupcake type).

The cupcake taste-off entries will be judged on flavor, texture, density, and appearance.

Competitors may submit up to three (3) entries per entry

registration fee. However, each entry can be in only one Category. (For example a gluten-free chocolate cupcake can be entered in the chocolate cupcake category or the gluten-free category but not both.) You may submit multiple entries into a single category, but each recipe can only submitted once.

Competitors are required to submit ten (10) standard sized-cupcakes for each entry. Four cupcakes will be selected for judging, the remaining cupcakes will be used for the cupcake raffle.

Cupcakes, frosting and any fillings must be made from scratch; no mixes or premade frostings/fillings can be used. Entries must include the use of King Arthur Cake Flour and/or King Arthur Unbleached All-Purpose Flour and/or King Arthur Gluten-Free Flour in the recipe. **The recipe must accompany the entry.** The entry and the recipe become the property of the Bristol Cake Show and King Arthur Flour. Recipes submitted must be the original creation of entrant and the recipe must not have been previously published. The competitor cannot have won prizes or awards in other contests for the submitted recipe. The recipe must be printed on a standard 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper with no identification as to the identity of the competitor.

Baked goods should be prepared in a sanitary manner. Judges reserve the right to disqualify any entry they deem to be potentially unsafe to eat. All entries will be stored at room temperature, do not submit cupcakes which require refrigeration.

Entries, platters/plates, containers, etc. will not be returned. Please use disposable plates/containers for your entries.

All entries must arrive before 11 a.m. on Saturday, April 6, 2019 (no exceptions). Entries can be delivered between 2 p.m.-6 p.m. on Friday, April 5th and 8:30 a.m.-10:30 a.m. on Saturday, April 6th. The Cupcake Taste-Off is part of the Bristol Cake Show and is being held at Bristol Community College, 777 Elsbree Street, Fall River, MA. Cupcake Taste-Off competitors will need to deliver their entries to the College Commonwealth Center (G building). Parking is available on the side of the building (lot 12).

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
